



2.3 The SALTO-YOUTH Resource Centres³

The European Commission has created eight Resource Centres to support the work of the National Agencies and other structures and beneficiaries of the programme.

These Resource Centres are called SALTO-YOUTH, and their role is to provide different kinds of resources and support to improve the quality of youth projects in priority areas.

The SALTO-YOUTH Resource Centres provide training courses, training tools, information about good practice, networks and partnerships development, partner-Inding, etc. They work in close co-operation with the National Agencies to reach the users of the Youth in Action Programme.

The creation of the SALTO-YOUTH RCs dates from the year 2000 and evolved towards true Resource Centres on a specific priority or region. Currently, there are eight such centres, working on eight priorities.

 The SALTO Cultural Diversity RC is based in the United Kingdom and focuses on promoting tolerance and diversity in Europe;

 The SALTO Inclusion RC is based in Belgium and promotes social inclusion, while striving for inclusion of all youth in the Youth in Action Programme;

 The SALTO Participation RC (formerly known as Youth Initiatives) is based in Belgium and is aimed at supporting the European dimension of Youth Initiatives and Youth Democracy Projects, the new Actions 1.2 and 1.3;

- The SALTO Euro-Med RC is based in France and works on co-operation in the field of youth in the Figo-Mediterranean basin;
- The SALTO South-East Europe RC is based in Slovenia and promotes the cooperation between the Programme Countries and the Neighbouring Partner Countries of South-East Europe in the field of youth;

 The SALTO Eastern Europe and Caucasus RC is based in Poland and supports the cooperation between the Programme Countries of Eastern Europe and Caucasus and thus bridges youth co-operation between Western and Eastern Europe;

 The SALTO Information RC is operated by the Swedish National Agency and the Hungarian National Agency and is aimed at facilitating the communication between SALTO-YOUTH ROs, National Agencies, and European commission;



 The SALTO Training and Co-operation RC is based in Germany and is aimed at contributing to the development of a coherent European Training Strategy⁶ within the Youth in Action Programme.

Since 2000, the SALTO Training and Cooperation RC supports the quality development of the national Training and Co-operation Plans (TOPs) of the National Agencies, co-ordinates Europeanvide training offers, fosters the cooperation between the different stateholders of the European Training Strategy, and disseminates results, hools, and good practice.

Within this context, the SALTO Training and Cooperation RC also organises the so-called NA Network Training Courses (TGS), training courses at European level for European youth workers, multipliers, and trainers financed by the TCP budget of the NAs. To implement the different courses, SALTO co-operates closely with a pool of European trainers and with the network of National Agencies.
